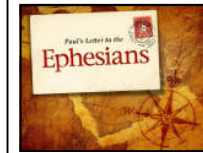

Canada Revenue Agency has a program called Community Volunteer Income Tax Program. This program is for individuals not able to fill out their own income tax forms or pay for someone to do it for them. Suggested Eligibility Criteria are:

Total Family Net Income Should Not Be More Than:

Single Person \$30,000

Married Couple \$35,000

Single Parent with 1 child \$35,000

Each additional child \$2,500 extra
